## Person Place & Thing Story - Editing checklist

- TITLE and NAME at the top (Title is capitalized, name on second line is capitalized)
- CAPITALS, beginning of sentences and proper nouns have capital (names of people, things and places)
- **SPELLING**, check for errors
- PUNCTUATION, questions have question marks, dialogue has quotation marks, periods at end of sentences...
- RUN ONs are your sentences too long?
- INCOMPLETEs check for missing subject or actions
- PARAGRAPH BREAKS do you have one main subject for each paragraph?
- TENSE are you consistent with staying in PAST or PRESENT or FUTURE?
- DESCRIBE (don't just tell) have you described/ shown the reader what is happening in an interesting and creative way?
- CHARACTERS do we know enough about them to CARE about them?
- LITERARY TOOLS have I used a good number of these to add creativity and interest to my story:
  - a) simile and metaphor
  - b) hyperbole
  - c) zoomorphism
  - d) alliteration
  - e) foreshadowing
  - f) personification
  - g) onomatopoeia
- **STORYLINE** (Plotline)
  - a) described setting and characters enough?
  - b) created enough rising action (building tension/ problems)?
  - c) will the reader feel anxious at the climax and want to keep reading?
  - d) included enough falling actions to resolve main problem adequately
  - e) all 'loose ends' have been wrapped up (solved/explained)
  - f) ending is fitting to the story
